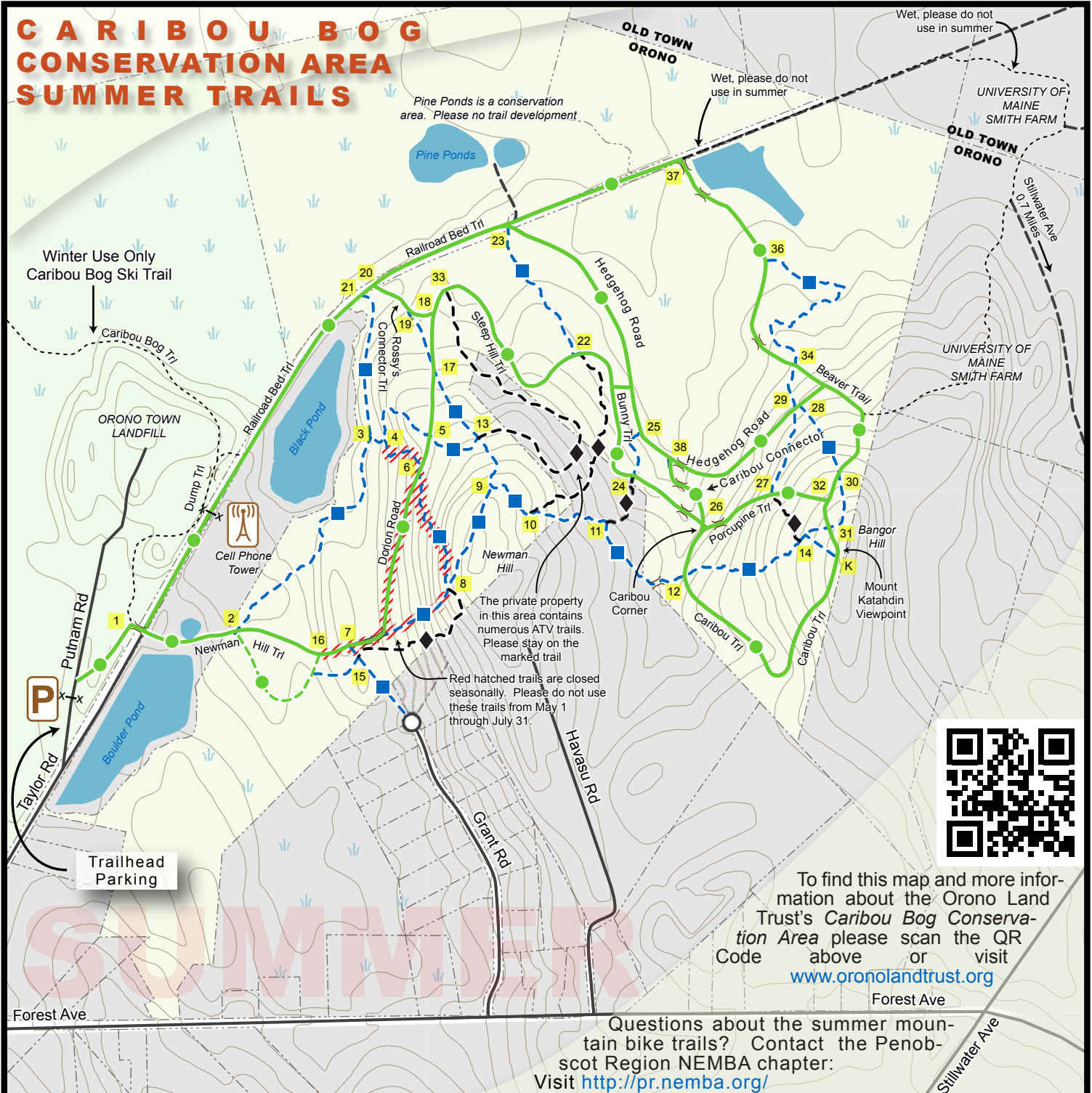


CARIBOU BOG CONSERVATION AREA SUMMER TRAILS

Caribou Bog Ski Trail

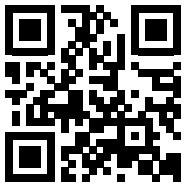
Pine Ponds is a conservation area. Please no trail development
